CONDITIONS OF PERMIT

In approving this right of way use application, all work is subject to the inspection and control of the City's Engineering Department. Permittee MUST contact the Engineering Department inspector, Jeff Bertison at 512-401-5360 2 business days prior to starting any work. An on site preconstruction meeting is required.

A plan and profile drawing showing proposed construction and City utility lines and sizes must be attached to this application.

There shall be no boring under or over water transmission mains 12" or greater in size or any wastewater force mains.

All work shall be performed in accordance with City of Cedar Park's applicable Ordinances and Regulations.

Provide and attach *Proof of Liability**, *Cost Estimate** and a *one year Maintenance Bond** (10% of construction cost) with this application. *Cash or a letter of credit meeting City's conditions in the amount of 50% of the construction cost may be used as an alternative to the Maintenance Bond. Upon completion and City's final approval of the improvements, the surety amount will be refunded.* In obtaining this permit, the contractor performing the work assumes all liability for any damages done to any utilities, streets, and sidewalks in the area where the work is being performed and the bond, cash or letter of credit shall be used by City if applicant fails to complete the project or fails to fully cure any damages caused to City. Such bond shall have as surety a corporation licensed to do business in the State of Texas as a surety company. If damaged, the utilities, streets and sidewalks shall be repaired by the contractor to satisfaction of the City of Cedar Park. A traffic control plan which meets all applicable MUTCD standards is required if construction will occur on a public roadway.
