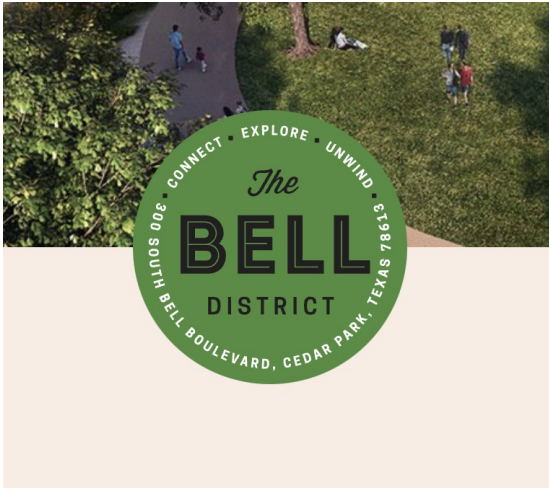

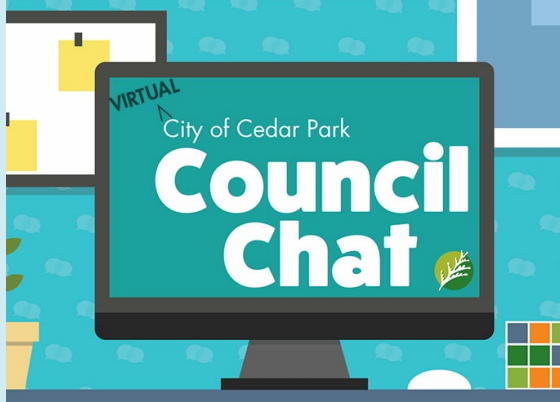

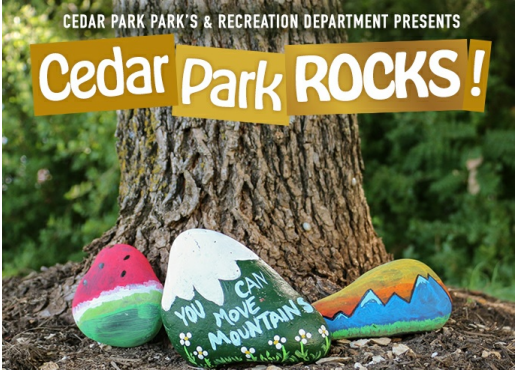

The August 12, 2021 Regular Scheduled City Council Meeting was entirely remote, with City Council Members and the public participating in a video conference call that was streamed and broadcasted live on our website and television channel.



Highlights included:

- Setting of a maximum tax rate of 43.2 cents per \$100 of property valuation and discussion of the Proposed FY 22 Budget, with public hearings set for September 2 and September 9
