

- I. The City of Cedar Park Water Distribution Department will conduct fire hydrant flow tests on public owned hydrants. If the hydrant is private, then you will need to hire a third party to perform the test. To check if a hydrant is public or privately owned, go to <https://cedarparkatlas.com/atlas.aspx?Section=All-In-One>
  1. Click on the **Layer List drop down**
  2. Select **Water Distribution System**
  3. In the “**Find Address or Place**” box, **type in the address of the hydrant**
  4. Click on the red circles (*these are fire hydrants*) and
  5. Click on the right facing arrow until you get to the last page
  6. Scroll to the bottom of the page until you see “**ServiceUse**” this will indicate if the hydrant is public or private
  7. At the top of the page is “**HydrantID**”, you will need the id to include in your request
  
- II. If the hydrant is public, send an email request to [pwadmin@cedarparktexas.gov](mailto:pwadmin@cedarparktexas.gov) and include the following information:
  1. The address of the location
  2. A map clearly showing the locations of both hydrants
  3. Indicate which is the Flow and which is the Static Residual hydrant
  4. The **HydrantID**
  5. Your Name, Company Name, Address, Email and Phone Number
  
- III. After the City receives your request, there is a 7 to 10 business day turnaround time and there is no charge for the test.
  
- IV. You will receive a verification email that your request has been received and that a technician will be contacting you.
