

ORDINANCE NO. CO46.18.09.13.E1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CEDAR PARK, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 9, HUMAN RESOURCES, ARTICLE 9.11 MUNICIPAL CIVIL SERVICE, SECTION 9.11.002 CLASSIFICATION AND NUMBER OF POSITIONS IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALER; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS ORDINANCE IS PASSED WAS NOTICED AND IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, the City of Cedar Park has adopted Civil Service for its Fire Department employees; and

WHEREAS, the City Council shall establish the Classifications pursuant to Chapter 143.021 of the Texas Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the existing number of positions in each classification in the Fire Department is as follows:

- 1) Assistant Chief \*\*\* – 2
- 2) Battalion Chief \*\* – 5
- 3) Lieutenant\* – 19
- 4) Driver/Engineer – 15
- 5) Firefighter – 37

\* A member of the Fire Department classified as Lieutenant will be appointed as a Fire Inspector.

\*\* A member of the Fire Department classified as a Battalion Chief will be appointed as the Assistant Fire Marshal.

\*\*\* A member of the Fire Department classified as an Assistant Fire Chief will be appointed as the Fire Marshal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CEDAR PARK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Effective September 13, 2018, the number of positions in each classification for the Fire Department shall be as follows:

- 1) Assistant Chief \*\*\* – 2
- 2) Battalion Chief \*\* – 5
- 3) Lieutenant\* – 19
- 4) Driver/Engineer – 15
- 5) Firefighter – 42

\* A member of the Fire Department classified as Lieutenant will be appointed as a Fire Inspector.



\*\*A member of the Fire Department classified as a Battalion Chief will be appointed as the Assistant Fire Marshal.

\*\*\*A member of the Fire Department classified as an Assistant Fire Chief will be appointed as the Fire Marshal.

SECTION 2. That the provisions of this ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any word, phrase or part of this ordinance shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meetings at which this ordinance was introduced and passed were open to the public and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meetings were given all as required by law.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after the date of approval.
