Designation of Recount Committee Member

A recount has been ordered for the above-referenced Election. The recount will be conducted in accordance with the applicable provisions of Texas Election Code, Title 13, particularly Chapter 213 Conduct of Recount and Chapter 214 Counting Procedures. As Recount Coordinator/Supervisor, I will be appointing a Recount Committee to administer the recount process.

We are asking each Candidate to designate one (1) member to serve on the Recount Committee. That member must be a registered voter of the City of Cedar Park and may not have participated as an Election Judge or on the Early Voting Ballot Board. The designated member will serve as a vote counter responsible for tallying the votes as ballots are read.

Please be advised that I am also contacting the Democratic and Republican Parties of Williamson County to request their designation of one (1) member each to serve on the Committee in the same capacity.

The designated members are not considered to be Recount Watchers and do not count against each Candidate's allowed appointment of up to two (2) watchers.

The recount will be conducted on Tuesday, May 21st beginning at 9:00 a.m., and if necessary, Wednesday, May 22nd. Committee members should arrive no later than 8:30 a.m.
