



Reminder: Fireworks Ban



Did you know only professional, licensed fireworks displays are allowed? The Cedar Park Police Department will strictly enforce the fireworks ordinance. This ordinance applies to all areas within the city limits and the unincorporated areas within 5,000 feet of the city limits. Maximum fine for this offense is \$2,000. City of Cedar Park officially opens Fire Station Number 5

The City of Cedar Park and Williamson County hosted the Grand Opening Ceremony for Fire Station Number 5 on Friday, May 3, 2019. The new station is located at 1501 Cottonwood Creek Trail. It houses the Cedar Park Fire Department as well as the Williamson County EMS. At the ceremony, City and County leaders and staff were joined by chiefs, directors, firefighters and paramedics from the Cedar Park Fire Department and Williamson County EMS. It began with a blessing of the new station, the fire hose uncoupling and the station tones from emergency dispatchers and the ceremonial push of Quint 5 into the bay, to officially open the station.

Fight the Bite!



What you can do

Mosquitoes breed in standing or stagnant water. The City's Parks and Recreation Department uses *bacillus thuringiensis* (Bt) larvicide tablets on public property (such as parks) to treat any standing water that cannot be drained. Bt is a naturally-occurring bacteria that is harmless to people and most pets

but it interrupts the reproduction cycle of mosquitoes. You can find Bt for home use at most "big box" hardware retailers.

As part of its *Fight the Bite* campaign the Health District recommends the 3 Ds of mosquito safety.

- Drain standing water in flower pots, pet dishes or clogged gutters so mosquitoes don't have a place to breed and treat water that can't be drained,
- Defend by using an EPA-approved insect repellent, and
- Dress in long sleeves and pants when outdoors.

In addition, the City's Code Enforcement Division is focusing its efforts on mosquito abatement throughout the community. If you are aware of a location of stagnant water on public or private property, please report it to the City's Code Enforcement Division via the CP Connect 2.0 app or www.cedarparktexas.gov/ReportaProblem.
