Changes to Accounts:

Any changes a customer's account must be made in writing to the Utility Department. They can be sent in via Fax, Email, Mail, or delivered in person at our office. Our fax number is (512)401-5301 and our email address is ub@cedarparktexas.gov.

Payments:

There are several options for paying your bill.

- 1) At our Office Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. till 5 p.m. We are located at 450 Cypress Creek Rd, Bldg. #2. We accept Cash, Checks, Money Orders, and Credit Cards (Visa or MasterCard only).
- 2) At our Night Drop Box in our parking lot, across from Building 4 Payments dropped here will be posted the next business morning.
- 3) By Mail and it will be credited on the day that we receive it.
- 4) By Phone at 512-401-5300 with either a Visa or MasterCard. A \$2.00 Credit Card processing fee will be charged for all payments of \$25.00 or more.
- 5) Thru our Website (<https://www.municipalonlinepayments.com/cedarparktexas>) with either a Visa or MasterCard. There is no processing fee and it is credited immediately to your account.
- 6) Direct draft from a checking or savings account or Visa or MasterCard for no processing fee. Please use the following link to connect you to the documents page. Then click on Automatic Debit Authorization form. Once completed, please send to the address at the top of the form. (Click here for documents)
- 7) You can also pay thru your Bank's Bill pay.

Billing Cycles:

There are 4 billing cycles in the city:

1. Cycle One - Mailed on the 17th and due by the 2nd.
2. Cycle Two - Mailed on the 24th and due on the 9th.
3. Cycle Three-Mailed on the 1st and due on the 16th.
4. Cycle Four - Mailed on the 8th and due by the 23rd.

Residents cannot change their billing cycles as they are determined by your geographic location. Bills are mailed once per month and are due before 5 pm on the due date. Late payments are subject to a 10% penalty fee. Late cut-off notices are mailed the day following the due dates of all accounts owing a balance. The notice will include a final due date. If payment is not received by this deadline, service will be suspended. A \$50 disconnect fee plus the balance owed must be paid before the service is restored. It is a state felony to turn disconnected water back on before payment of all fees and charges.

Deposits:

Residential accounts require a deposit of \$100 that will be assessed on to the customer's first billing statement. The deposit can be waived with an acceptable letter of credit from another Utility Company (Gas, Electric, or Water). The letter of credit can have no more than 1 late payment, no disconnects for non-payment, no returned items, and be for the last 12 consecutive months.

Refund Policy:

After a year of good service, customers in good standing with no more than 1 late payment, no disconnects, and no returned items will receive a statement credit of their deposit. Otherwise, upon termination of your water service, the deposit on the account is applied to your final bill and any remaining credit will be sent back to you in the form of a check.

Garbage/Recycling:

Weekly garbage and every other week recycling service will be provided by Cedar Park Disposal for residents inside the city limits and billed on your water bill. Extra garbage cans are available for an additional monthly charge. The weekly trash and recycling schedule is available on our website. Water:

Tiered Water Rate Structure

Base Rate \$17.77 includes the first 2,000 gallons of usage

Tier 1 \$3.63 per 1,000 gallons of usage from 2,001 - 10,000 gallons

Tier 2 \$4.36 per 1,000 gallons of usage from 10,001 - 15,000 gallons

Tier 3 \$5.23 per 1,000 gallons of usage over 15,000 gallons

Sewer:

Sewer rates are based on the average water readings for December, January, and February on your account. The average is calculated at this time of year because there is less outdoor water usage. Your new sewer rate will appear on your April bill and will remain the same until April of the following year. The minimum charge for a 2,000 gallon winter average is \$21.70. Each additional 1,000 gallons is \$3.99. New residents with no usage in the winter will have their wastewater based on the current citywide winter average or their actual water usage whichever is less, until a winter average has been calculated.

RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE SERVICES FOR CEDAR PARK RESIDENTS

RATE: The total monthly rate is \$19.43 (which includes a 95 gallon trash cart and a 95 gallon recycling cart) and is included on your monthly water bill. Only 95 gallon carts are available.

ADDITIONAL CARTS: Cost for an additional 95 gallon cart is \$5.50 per month. To order call Utility Billing at (512) 401-5300.

BAG LIMITS: Cedar Park Disposal will collect up to 7 additional bags or bulky item combination along with their garbage cart each week.

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SERVICES –

BASIC SERVICES: Garbage is collected once per week and recycling every other week. (Recycling is not mandatory.)

Garbage carts and recycle carts must be placed curbside NO LATER THAN 7AM. The garbage cart needs to be placed within two feet of the edge of the street or at the curb with the handle toward the curb.

Service days are Monday – Friday, except for the Holiday Schedule affecting New Year’s Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. The slide schedule would move your pickup to the next day. (Example: During Thanksgiving week, Thursday collection will occur on Friday, and Friday pick up would occur on Saturday.)

BULK ITEMS: Put these out on your normal service day (7 item limits applies).

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Large items such as washers, dryers, stoves, mattresses, refrigerant-free refrigerators (door removed), freezers and air conditioners tagged by a licensed refrigerant technician (tag certifies that refrigerant has been removed). Tree, shrub and brush trimmings securely tied together forming an easily handled package not exceeding four feet in length, no more than four inches in diameter, and 50 lbs. in weight.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Household hazardous waste, tires, dirt, rocks, concrete, batteries, roofing shingles, ammunitions, explosives, compressed gasses and propane tanks cannot be collected. Any construction debris - may be hauled away in a special container leased from CTR. Call CTR at 512-243-2833 for more information.

****ABSOLUTELY NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS OF ANY KIND CAN BE ACCEPTED FOR PICK UP****

SPECIAL SERVICES: Additional bulky waste collection and disposal per Residential Customer request per visit at an additional cost. Call CPD at 243-2833 to schedule a special collection or receive price quotes for special tree or brush collection.

DISABLED SERVICES: Available with documentation from your doctor and if there is no one living at the residence able to help. Please contact the Cedar Park Utility Billing Department (512) 401-5300 for assistance.

RECYCLING SERVICES:

NEWSPAPERS/MAGAZINES/PAPERBOARD: Most paper that is not contaminated with food residue may be recycled. Such as newspaper, magazines, office paper, junk mail, and paperboard (cereal boxes, shoe boxes, gift boxes, and most food packaging containers. It is not necessary to remove inserts. NO PIZZA BOXES OR WET PAPER OF ANY TYPE CAN BE RECYCLED.

PLASTICS: Any hard plastic container that is marked with # 1 thru # 7. Remove caps and rings and flatten before placing in the recycle bin. NO STYROFOAM

CANS: Please rinse and drain completely. Do not put them inside any bag, paper or plastic. AEROSOL CANS OF ANY TYPE OR SCRAP METAL CANNOT BE COLLECTED WITH RECYCLING.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD: Please flatten and tie corrugated cardboard boxes into bundles for easy collection or if small enough place in the recycling cart. WET CARDBOARD CANNOT BE RECYCLED

GLASS: All Colors. NO DRINKING GLASSES, PYREX, OR LIGHT BULBS.
