

FALL WEEKLY YARD TRIMMINGS RECYCLING IS HAPPENING OCTOBER 19 - 30, 2020

Why is this happening?

This is a service enhancement that is being offered for six weeks in the spring and these two weeks in the fall. During this time, yard trimmings need to be placed in paper bags so they may be recycled instead of going to the landfill.

Will yard trimmings still be picked up outside of this timeframe?

Yes, as long as the guidelines for size, weight, bundling, wet bags and other bulk waste guidelines are followed.

The yard trimmings picked up outside of the listed recycling dates will not be recycled. They will go to the landfill.

I saw a worker put my yard trimmings into my trash cart, and my cart was emptied into the truck. Is this typical?

Yes. Any time outside of the yard trimmings recycling schedule, workers may place smaller yard trimmings into the trash cart for it to be emptied into the truck.

Do items count towards bulk items limit?

During this recycling period, no. However, outside of the yard trimmings recycling dates, yard trimmings are picked up as trash and taken to the landfill and do count towards your bulk limit of seven (7) items outside of your trash cart.

Why is yard trimmings recycling not offered year-round?

We strive to keep costs low and service level high. Recycling yard trimmings is a service enhancement that we have been able to work into our schedule and still keep costs low.

My regular recycling collection is biweekly. How often is my yard trimmings recycling?

During this period trimmings will be picked up weekly.

By what time should I set out my yard trimmings?

As with your trash and other recycling, please always set out your yard trimmings by 7 a.m. on your designated trash pickup day—leave out until collected.

Placing Yard Trimmings

- Branches no more than **four (4) feet long and four (4) inches in diameter**. Please bundle them. Bundles may weigh **no more than 50 pounds**.
- Use paper lawn waste bags for smaller trimmings, such as leaves and grass clippings. Clippings in plastic bags will **not be accepted**.
- **No wet bags** due to heavy weight and risk of breakage. If there is wet weather, please wait for dry weather to set out bags.
- Set out bags a **minimum of three (3) feet** from trash and recycling carts.



If your trash and/or recycling is not picked up by the end of the day, **please leave it out and call Cedar Park Disposal's Customer Service office at 512-243-2833** so that we may service it the following business day.
