At the discretion of the PACE Board, non-agenda items under the headings of "Citizen Communications" may be presented to the Board for informational purposes; however, by law, the Board shall not discuss, deliberate or vote upon such matters except that a statement of specific factual information, a recitation of existing policy, and deliberations concerning the placing of the subject on a subsequent agenda may take place.
